The Library Meaningful Improvement Project is funded by \$10.6M in state and federal grants. All funds must be expended by March 31, 2026. The renovation of the Library at 440 W Sierra Madre Blvd. includes a 5,000 square foot expansion, an additional south facing entrance, updating the building for seismic and ADA, and updating the Library grounds.
