Father Boyle to Speak in Sierra Madre - Hear from Author Father Gregory Boyle during One Book One City

One Book One City is a community reading program which invites everyone in Sierra Madre to read and discuss the same book during February 2020 and attend exciting programs. Barking to the Choir reveals the success of using “radical kinship” and compassion to transform the lives of gang members in Los Angeles.
