The Sierra Madre Fire Department's S.M.A.R.T. Chipper & Green Waste Days are designed to provide residents the opportunity to dispose of flammable vegetation free of charge. Residents living above Grandview Ave. are eligible to register to receive free curbside vegetation hauling and chipping services.

REGISTRATION WILL OPEN FROM 02/08/24 AND CLOSE ON 02/22/24.

HOW IT WORKS:

- Must be a Sierra Madre homeowner living above Grandview Ave. Must register by Thursday, February 22nd.
- Homeowners are responsible for conducting their own trimming and vegetation maintenance and hauling it curbside for pick-up.

- · Registered participants are asked to place all stacked vegetation curbside, by 8AM on day of event. Please do not place stacked vegetation on public walkways or emergency access lanes.
- Licensed tree trimmers will pick up vegetation that has been placed curbside to all registered participants. Crews will be sure to pick up and clean any leftover debris.
 All vegetation and green waste collected will be hauled to City Yards where it will be chipped,
- recycled, and/or reused for future mulch use and giveaways.
- Please have all vegetation curbside and ready for pick-up by 8AM on day of event. Pick-up times will vary depending on the number of participating residences. Homes located in the canyon area will be prioritized for early pick up times. All hauling services are expected to be completed by 4PM but may run longer depending on the amount of vegetation collected.
